

Minnesota Prairie Chicken Society \$1000 Scholarship 2022 Guidelines

- Minnesota Prairie Chicken Society (MPCS) will award one scholarship in the amount of \$1000 to an undergraduate college student who has completed at least three semesters (or the equivalent in trimesters/quarters) in wildlife sciences, natural resource management or closely related field.
- Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher and plan on continuing studies in the field of wildlife science, natural resource management or closely related field (e.g., environmental science, ecology, forestry, fisheries management, conservation biology).
- Recipients will be chosen on the basis of: A) scholastic and school achievement, B) community involvement, C) a 250–500 word essay describing their educational & career goals, and D) at least one letter of reference from an employer, professor, or school counselor.
 - Preference will be given to Minnesota residents and applicants who have worked or volunteered for an agency or organization in the wildlife sciences, conservation, environmental or natural resource fields.
 - NOTE: References must address, among other things, why they feel the applicant would be likely to succeed in a wildlife science, natural resource management or closely related field.
- The scholarship selection committee will be comprised of at least three members of the MPCS Board. Students may obtain scholarship application forms from a professor in the college natural resources department or MPCS at the address below or on the website at www.prairiechickens.org. Applications should be returned to MPCS Scholarship, Terry Lydell, 1552 148th Ave NW, Andover, MN 55304-3459, no later than March 4, 2022. Questions may be directed to terrylydell@qualityci.us.
- Successful selection will be announced to the student, college professor and the local area newspaper.

NOTE: Payment of scholarship will be made upon successful completion of the current semester or equivalent with proof from the institution of the student's enrollment. Payment will be made directly to the student. An MPCS Scholarship recipient may reapply for a following year scholarship when the new scholarship guidelines are released.
